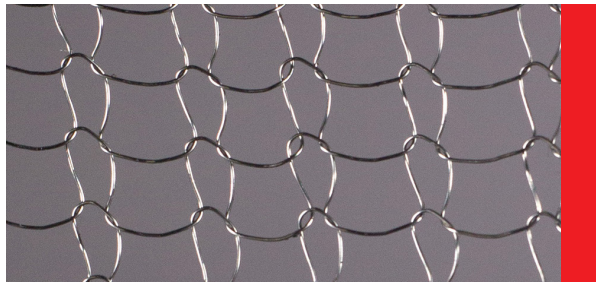

### Why use Flexi Armour Ground Mesh

Flexi Armour Ground Mesh is part of Rentokil's Flexi Armour range of rodent proofing solutions.

The sturdy ground covering averts burrowing pests by creating a mesh barrier around your premises to inhibit tunnel excavation and damage.

It's twice as robust as standard 'chicken wire' mesh. Chicken wire mesh is made from galvanised mild steel, so it typically only has a lifespan of less than two years once buried. While chicken wire mesh is soft and can easily be gnawed or clawed by vermin or broken by natural growth, Flexi Armour mesh is flexible, tough and inert.

The smallest hole size available in the chicken mesh is also 13mm x 13mm – meaning some vermin can still burrow through. Flexi Armour Mesh's tight-knit structure tackles this and restricts more pests, offering greater protection of your facilities.

Flexi Armour Mesh is also quicker and easier to install than chicken/weld mesh, typically halving installation time, so your premises can be protected quicker and you can spend more time focusing on your business operations with peace of mind.
